From the Executive Director...

Dear Friends,

Thank you so much for your ongoing support of Inter-Faith Community Services. As you are aware, Inter-Faith is the largest non-governmental human services agency serving western and unincorporated Arapahoe County and northern Douglas County. Our more than 40 years of social services experience, coupled with individualized case management, means the difference between clients' reliance on public assistance and the development of self-sufficiency.

The year which this annual report summarizes can be encapsulated in this remark: I would say on behalf of my staff: "We are proud of our accomplishments, which are many - but we are so tired."

We have seen true human suffering increase as needs grow and services are slashed in our service area. Our case managers are working harder and smarter every year. Sometimes it feels overwhelming when, for almost four years now, we have been averaging 50 to 60 new clients coming to our door each month - those new clients are in addition to the hundreds we are already working with monthly.

We are seeing decent, hard-working parents struggle to hold down two or three jobs and still "be there" for their children; we are seeing seniors face the decision of whether to go hungry or buy their prescribed medicines; we are seeing families who cannot pay increasingly high utility bills confront homelessness. Inter-Faith is here both as a safety net and more importantly as a pathway to self-sufficiency.

There is no way we would be able to continue the important work that we do in this community without your help. On behalf of the thousands of people you have affected this year alone, please accept my heartfelt thanks and request for your continued support.

REPORT OF SERVICE

SEPTEMBER 1, 2003 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2004

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- \$199,785 was used to assist 1,008 individuals to prevent homelessness.
- \$ 29,635 was used to assist 1,639 individuals with prescriptions, gas vouchers, bus tokens, birth certificates, Sargent Fund and hearing aids.
- \$ 49,100 was used to assist 171 individual victims of crime.

BASIC NEEDS

- 6,621 individuals received 99,315 meals. Each individual received enough food for three meals a day for 5 days. An estimated dollar amount of \$331,050 (\$10 per individual per day).
- 2,624 individuals received clothing from the clothing bank. An estimated dollar amount of \$104,960 (\$40 per individual).

YOUTH SERVICES

- 403 children received new clothes and school supplies through the Pack to School Program.
- 203 additional children received backpacks and school supplies.
- 4 children attended Salvation Army Summer Camp.

SENIOR SERVICES

- 12 Seniors received services from Inter-Faith Lunch Bunch and grocery shopping.
- 436 trips were provided to assist with medical and senior needs.

NEW CLIENTS

- 673 new families came to Inter-Faith for assistance.

OTHER SERVICES

- The Sargent Fund - Food for Learning Program provided 11,750 lunches to school children who could not afford to buy lunch.
- 24 individuals received eye glasses through Inter-Faith's Gift of Sight program.
- 1,071 Holiday Baskets were distributed to those in need in our service area.
- 42 individuals accessed the Inter-Faith Career Center.
- 3,768 referrals to other organizations were provided to those in need.
- 4,088 volunteer hours were given to Inter-Faith by 862 volunteers.

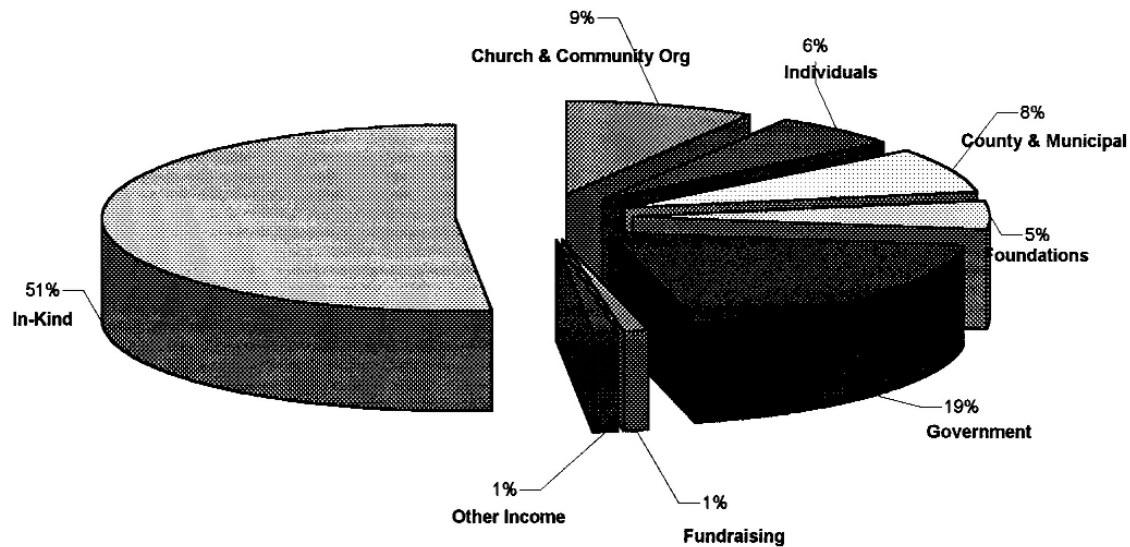

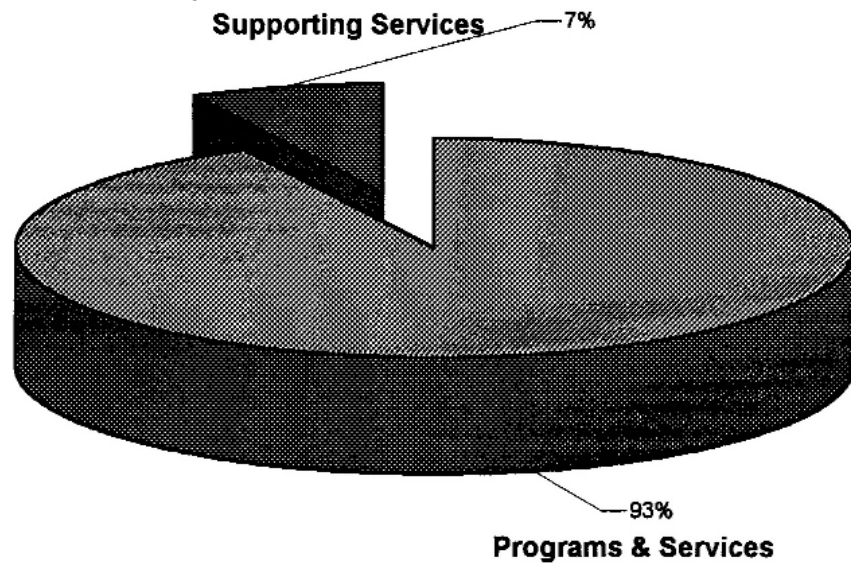

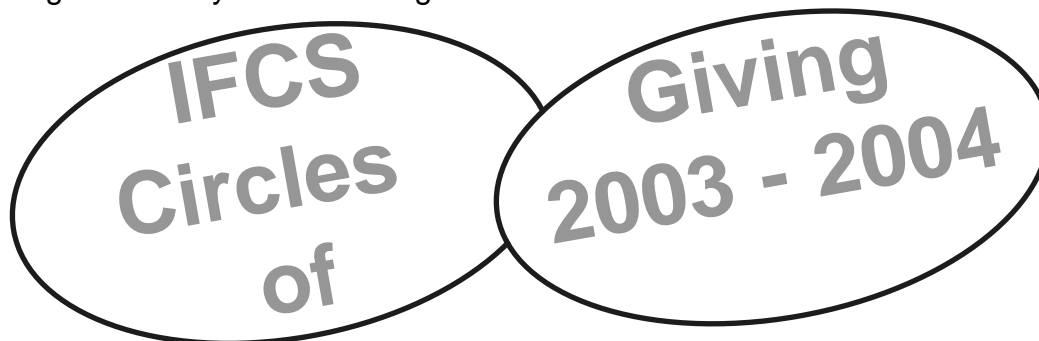

A Little History...

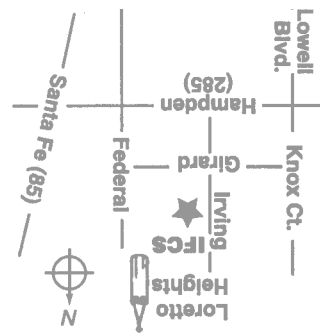
In 1964 in response to growing community needs relating to serving the working-poor, indigent and homebound elderly in South Metro Denver, leaders from all segments of the community - led by Inter-Faith founder Maida Navis - came together in what was and is truly a community-based effort to form Inter-Faith Task Force for Community Services (now Inter-Faith Community Services).

Starting with simple programming designed to meet the basic human needs of food, clothing and shelter, Inter-Faith has grown into the largest emergency and continual support systems in South Metro Denver for low-income families, children and seniors. Inter-Faith is dedicated to providing services that bridge the gaps between crisis, survival and independence. In 1968 Inter-Faith was designated the "official poverty agency" in its service area and together, with the board, staff, volunteers and community support, the agency has served numerous low-income persons since its inception. With a philosophy of a "**hand up, not a hand out**" the agency strives to support its clients in every phase of their climb to self-sufficiency and success.
