



**REPORT OF SERVICES
SEPTEMBER 1, 2012 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2013**

17,852 low-income individuals were served during fiscal year 2012-2013

NEW CLIENTS

▶ 686 new families, individuals, and senior citizens came to IFCS for assistance

HOMELESS PREVENTION

▶ 549 individuals received homelessness prevention assistance, totaling \$172,809

HUNGER PREVENTION

▶ 7,210 individuals received hunger prevention assistance, totaling \$1,009,400. Meals distributed-151,860

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

▶ 944 individuals received assistance with medical prescriptions, transportation, birth certificates, hearing aids, and Sargent Fund, totaling \$5,575

▶ 287 crime victims received assistance, totaling \$65,438

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

▶ Ready, Set, School!

- 537 children received new clothes, backpacks, and school supplies-Ready, Set, School!
- 564 children received backpacks and school supplies-Project Backpack

▶ Holiday Program

- 3,893 individuals received food and gifts for Thanksgiving and Christmas
- 200 children received toys for Christmas

SENIOR PROGRAM

▶ 40 seniors participated in Lunch Bunch, Grocery Shopping and Medical Transportation programs

▶ 118 seniors received food and gifts for Thanksgiving and Christmas

OTHER ASSISTANCE

▶ 2,249 individuals received clothing, totaling \$89,960

▶ 1,184 individuals benefited from receiving recreation passes from South Suburban and Englewood Recreation, distributed through IFCS

▶ 58 individuals accessed the IFCS' Career Center

▶ 19 individuals received eyeglasses through IFCS' Gift of Sight program

REFERRALS

▶ 8,088 referrals were made to other organizations

VOLUNTEERS

▶ 2,557 volunteers gave 9,273 volunteer hours
